# Cwpan Cymru-Welsh FA Cup

Sefydlwyd y Cwpan Cymdeithas Pêl-droed Cymru yn 1877. Does dim ond dwy gystadleuaeth bêl droed hynach yn y byd sef Cwpan FA Lloegr a'r Alban.

Roedd Dolgellau yn cystadlu yn ail flwyddyn bodolaeth y gwpant yn 1878 gan golli yn y rownd 1af i Newtown White Stars o 3-0. Roedd blyn-yddoedd gyntaf y gystadleuaeth yn cael ei rheoli gan dimau o'r gogledd a dim ond yn 1912 gwelwyd enw o'r de ar y gwpant pan enillodd Cardiff City y gwpant am y tro cyntaf.



Hyd at 1996 roedd y clybiau roedd yn chwarae ym mhymrid Lloegr yn cael cystadlu ac mae enwau Caerdydd, Abertawe, Wrecsam a Casnewydd i'w gweld fel enillwyr llawer gwaith ond hefyd clybiau o Loegr fel Shrewsbury Town, Bristol City, Tranmere Rovers a Chester City. Ers 1996 dim ond clybiau ym mhymrid Cymru sy'n cystadlu. Deiliaid y Gwpan ydy'r Seintiau Newydd a enillodd yn 2019. (uchod)

Mae rhamant yn perthyn i unrhyw gwpant, y cyfre am sioc-Dafydd yn curo Goliath a bydd rhai ohonoch yn cofio i Bermo gyrraedd y 5ed Rownd yn 1969/70 a chwarae ym Mharc Ninian yn erbyn Caerdydd. Yr un tîm a gurodd Real Madrid yn Ewrop y flwyddyn ganlynol.



*The Welsh FA Cup is the third oldest football competition in the world. The English and Scottish FA Cups being older.*

*Believe it or not Dolgellau competed in the competition's second year loosing to Newtown White Star 3-0 in the first round back in 1878. (Wrexham 1878 winners left) The first years of the competition were dominated by clubs from the north and it wasn't until*

*1912 when a club from the south won the cup - Cardiff City the first of 22 trophy wins. A record only bettered by Wrexham with 23!*



*Up until 1996 clubs competing in the English pyramid competed in the Welsh Cup with Cardiff City, Swansea, Wrexham and Newport County often winners. But also we can see the names of Shrewsbury Town, Bristol city, Tranmere Rovers and Chester City as winners. Since 1996 only clubs are allowed to participate.*

*As with any cup competition there is the romance, the giant-killer. Some of you will remember Barmouth and Dyffryn Utd reaching the 5<sup>th</sup> Round in 1969/70 and taking on Cardiff City at Ninian Park. (Match programme right) That same Cardiff City team was to beat Real Madrid 1-0 in the following year's Cup-Winners Cup! (Frank Clark scores in Cardiff City's 1-0 over Real Madrid right)*



*We welcome our neighbour Machynlleth to the Marian this afternoon. Who knows, today could see the start of a memorable cup run for one of these teams.*

# ***Ein Gwrthwynebwyr-Our Oponents***

## **MACHYNLLETH FC**

Ffurfiwyd 'Y Magnolians' yn 1885, saith mlynedd ar ôl Dolgellau ac mae'r ddua gwlb â hanes eithaf tebyg er rhaid cyfaddef mai Machynlleth fu mwyaf llwyddiannus hyd yma.

Llwyddodd Machynlleth i gyrraedd tair rownd derfynol Cwpan Amatur Cymru, y tro cyntaf yn 1901, gan ennill y gystadleuaeth yn 1931. Y flwyddyn ganlynol ymunwyd â Chynghrair y Canolborth ond erbyn 1936 roedd y clwb wedi peidio a bod. Ail ffurfiwyd y clwb yn 1950 gan gystadlu yng Nghynghrair y Canolborth am ugain mlynedd. Ond yn 1971 daeth y clwb i ben unwaith eto gan ail-ffurfio yn 1974.

Erbyn y 90au roedd Machynlleth wedi sefydlu ei hun fel un o brif clybiau y canolborth gan ennill y Gynghrair dair gwaith rhwng 1993-95. Ond yn 1997 ymddiswyddodd y clwb o'r Gynghrair. Ond, unwaith eto daeth y Magnolians yn ôl gan ddod yn ail yn Nghynghrair y Canolborth ac ennill Cwpan y Gynghrair yn 2013/14.

Yn sgil dod yn ail yn Adran 2 Cynghrair y Canolborth fe ymunodd y clwb ag Ardal Cymru East.

Mae eu rheolwr Richie Evans yn gyn chwaraewr i'r clwb sydd hefyd wedi ymddangos dros Y Drenewydd, Aberystwyth, Llanidloes a Caersws.

*The Magnolians were formed back in 1885, seven years after Dolgellau and both club have shared chequered histories. One must admit that Mach have been the most successful up to now.*

*Machynlleth reached three Welsh Amateur Cup Finals, the first being in 1901. They went on to win what was then a very prestigious cup in 1931. The following year the club joined the Mid-Wales League only to fold in 1936. The club was reformed in 1950 and competed in the Mid-Wales League for 20 years. The club folded again in 1971 and reformed three years later.*

### **Centre Back/Mid-Harry Cottam**



*By the 90s Machynlleth had established themselves as one of mid Wales' most successful teams being champions on three consecutive years between 1993-95. But once again the club was resign from the league in 1997. Like the phoenix the club reformed and were league runner-up and League Cup winners in 2013/14.*

*Having finished as runners-up in Mid-Wales 2, Mach were invited to join Ardal Cymru East.*

*Their manager Richie Evans is a past player for the club having also represented Newtown, Aberystwyth, Llanidloes and Caersws.*
