# FAW TROPHY HISTORY

Sefydlwyd y gystadleuaeth a elwir bellach yn Tlws FAW yn 1890-91 fel y Welsh Junior Cup. Yn 1902 newidiwyd enw'r gystadleuaeth i Gwpan Amatur Cymru. Parhaodd yr enw yma hyd at 1974 pryd y diflannodd y statws amateur o'r gêm ac fe enwyd Gwpan Canolradd (Intermediate) Cymru. Yn 1993 rhoddywyd yr enw Tlws y Gymdeithas Bêl Droed arni.

Fel yng Nghwpan Cymru timau o ardal Wrecsam oedd rheoli'r gystadleuaeth yn y blynnyddoedd cyntaf. Serch hynny mae enwau sawl tîm arall o'r gogledd ar y tlws gan gynnwys sawl tîm o Feirionnydd. Enillodd Aberdyfi y Gwpan yn 1934 gan guro Aberystwyth 2-1. Yn 1957 y 55<sup>th</sup> Royal Artillery Tonfannau oedd yn fuddugol yn curo Porthmadog 3-1. Blaenau Ffestiniog aeth a'r gwpan yn 1979/80 pan drechwyd Gwaith Dur Brymbo 1-0.

Mae enw ein gwrtwhynebwyd heddiw ar y Gwpan yn ogystal. Machynlleth oedd yn fuddugol yn 1931/32 pan drechwyd Cardiff Corinthians 3-0. Cyrhaeddodd Machynlleth y rownd derfynol yn 1901/02, hefyd pan gollwyd 1-0 i Wrexham Victoria.

The FAW Trophy was established back in 1890/91 as the Welsh Junior Cup. In 1902 the name was changed to the Welsh Amateur Cup. The name remained until 1974 when amateur status was

displaced within the game and it was renamed the Welsh Intermediate Cup. In 1993 it was renamed the FAW Trophy.

As with the Welsh Cup the early years of the competition was dominated by teams from the Wrexham area. There are many other names from the north on the cup including a few from Meirionnydd. Aberdyfi won the Cup in 1934 beating Aberystwyth 3-1. In 1957/58 The 55<sup>th</sup> Royal Artillery Tonfannau won the Cup defeating Porthmadog 3-1 in the final. Blaenau Ffestiniog were winners in 1979/80 defeating Brymbo Steelworks 1-0.

Today's opponents Machynlleth also have their name on the Cup, being victorious in 1931/32 against Cardiff Corinthians 3-0. Machynlleth were

also runners-up in 1901/02 loosing to Wrexham Victoria (above) 1-0.

# ***Ein Gwrthwynebwyr-Our Oponents***

## **MACHYNLETH FC**

Ffurfiwyd 'Y Magnolians' yn 1885, saith mlynedd ar ôl Dolgellau ac mae'r ddau glwb â hanes eithaf tebyg er rhaid cyfaddef mai Machynlleth fu mwyaf llwyddiannus hyd yma.

Llwyddodd Machynlleth i gyrraedd dwy rownd derfynol Cwpan Amatur Cymru, y tro cyntaf yn 1901, gan ennill y gystadleuaeth yn 1931. Y flwyddyn ganlynol ymunwyd â Chyngahrain y Canolbarth ond erbyn 1936 roedd y clwb wedi peidio a bod. Ail ffurfiwyd y clwb yn 1950 gan gystadlu yng Nghyngahrain y Canolbarth am ugain mlynedd. Ond yn 1971 daeth y clwb i ben unwaith eto gan ail-ffurfio yn 1974.

Erbyn y 90au roedd Machynlleth wedi sefydlu ei hun fel un o brif clybiau y canolbarth gan ennill y Gynghrair dair gwaith rhwng 1993-95. Ond yn 1997 ymddiswyddodd y clwb o'r Gynghrair. Ond, unwaith eto daeth y Magnolians yn ôl gan ddod yn ail yn Nghyngahrain y Canolbarth ac ennill Cwpan y Gynghrair yn 2013/14.

Yn sgil dod yn ail yn Adran 2 Cynghrair y Canolbarth fe ymunodd y clwb ag Ardal Cymru East.

Mae eu rheolwr Richie Evans yn gyn chwaraewr i'r clwb, mae hefyd wedi ymddangos dros Y Drenowydd, Aberystwyth, Llanidloes a Chaersws.

*The Magnolians were formed back in 1885, seven years after Dolgellau and both club have shared chequered histories. One must admit that Mach have been the most successful up to now.*

*Machynlleth reached three Welsh Amateur Cup Finals, the first being in 1901. They went on to win what was then a very prestigious cup in 1931. The following year the club joined the Mid-Wales League only to fold in 1936. The club was reformed in 1950 and competed in the Mid-Wales League for 20 years. The club folded again in 1971 and reformed three years later.*

*By the 90s Machynlleth had established themselves as one of mid Wales' most successful teams being champions on three consecutive years between 1993-95. But once again the club was resign from the league in 1997. Like the phoenix, the club reformed and were league runner-up and League Cup winners in 2013/14.*

*Having finished as runners-up in Mid-Wales 2, Mach were invited to join Ardal Cymru East.*

*Their manager Richie Evans is a past player for the club having also represented Newtown, Aberystwyth, Llanidloes and Caersws.*
