

Seren Gyntaf Pêl droed Cymru!

Wrth groesau'r Waun i Ddolgellau heddiw mae'n anodd gwneud hynny heb beidio sôn am un o enwogion y dref honno a wnaeth cryn argraff ar y byd pêl-droed-sef Billy Meredith. Seren fawr gyntaf y byd pêl-droed.


Roedd Cymdeithas Pêl-droed Cymru wedi ei

ffurfio yn Wrecsam yn 1876. Yma hefyd chwaraewyd y gêm ryngwladol gyntaf yn erbyn Yr Alban yn y flwyddyn ganlynol gyda'r chwaraewyr i gyd yn chwarae i dimau'r Derwyddon o Rhiwabon, Wrecsam a Chroesoswallt. I'r berw yma y ganwyd Billy Meredith yn Y Waun yn 1874 yn fab i deulu o lowyr. Tra yn hogyn ifanc yn yr ysgol lleol daeth dan ddylanwad TE Thomas a datblygodd ei sgiliau pêl-droed. Yn hogyn 12 oed dilynnoddyntau ei dad a dechreuodd weithio dan daear yn y pwll lleol, Y Parc Du.

Yn 1892 cychwynnodd ei yrfa bêl-droed efo'i glwb lleol a helpodd Y Waun ennill Cwpan Cymru yn 1894. Roedd Meredith bellach yn gwneud cryn enw iddo'i hun ac ar un cyfnod roedd yn chwarae i'r Waun, Northwich Victoria a Manchester City tra hefyd yn gweithio yn y pwll o ddydd Llun tan ddydd Gwener! Ond, yn 1986 rodd-odd gorau i'w waith dan ddaear gan ddod yn beldroediwr proffesiynol.

Roedd Meredith yn chwaraewr hynod boblogaidd tra efo City, yn enwog am chwarae efo 'toothpick' yn ei geg, enillodd yr ail adran efo'r clwb ar ddua achlysur a Chwpan yr FA 1904. Yn anffodus yn ddiweddarach y flwyddyn honno cafodd Billy a sawl un o'i gyd-chwaraewyr eu gwahardd am golli gêm yn fwriadol yn erbyn Aston Villa, a hynny am £10!

Daeth yn ôl i'r gêm gan

ymuno a Manchester United 1906 tra'n dal dan waharddiad. Dechreuodd ail-chwarae yn 1907 a helpodd United i ennill y bencampwriaeth yn 1908 a 1911 ac hefyd Cwpan yr FA yn 1909. Gorfennodd ei yrfa yn ôl efo City ac yntau yn 50 oed! Enillodd 48 cap i Gymru gan sgorio 11 gôl.

Yn sicr roedd Billy o flaen ei amser. Doedd o ddim yn yfed na smocio, roedd yn ofalus iawn o'i ddiet yn ogystal. Roedd hefyd yn genedlaetholwr ac yn ddyn undeb mawr a cafodd ei wahardd am gyfnod yn dilyn sefydlu Undeb y Chwaraewyr neu'r PFA. Bu farw yn 1958 ac yntau yn 83 oed.

Wales' First Football Superstar!

Welcoming Chirk to Dolgellau this afternoon give us an opportunity to look at one of town's most famous sons-Billy Meredith. Probably football's first superstar.

The FA of Wales had been founded in Wrexham yn 1876, the first international played there a year later with players from Ruabon Druids, Wrexham and Oswestry making up the eleven and it was into this hotbed of football that Billy Meredith was born in Chirk in 1874 into a mining family. As a youngster he came under the influence of TE Thomas who helped him develop his footballing skills but at twelve years of age it was down the pit he went with his father starting work at the local Black Park Colliery.

His footballing career started in 1892 with his local side whom he helped win the Welsh Cup in 1894. Now making quite a name for himself in the football world he was turning out for Chirk, Northwich Victoria and Manchester City while still working as a miner. But in 1886 he gave up his colliery job to concentrate on his football becoming a professional with Manchester City.

He became a very popular player while at City. Famous for playing with a toothpick in his mouth, he helped them win the Second Division on two occasions and the FA Cup in 1904. Unfortunately he was then banned from playing along with other City player for taking a £10 bribe to throw a match against Aston Villa.

He returned to the game signing for Manchester United in 1906 while still banned. He resumed playing in 1907 helping United to the League Championship in 1908 and 1911 and the FA Cup in 1909. He was later to return to City, ending his career when he was 50 year old having also won 48 caps for Wales scoring 11 games.



Billy was certainly ahead of his time. He was a teetotal non smoker who also looked carefully at his diet. He was also a proud Welshman patriot and a staunch union man who was a leading figure in the setting up of the fledgling Player's Union for which he was banned for a while. He died in 1958 at the age of 83.

CROESO I'R WAUN—WELCOME CHIRK AAA FC

Chirk A.A.A. F.C. are one of the oldest clubs in Welsh soccer history having been founded in 1876. Chirk are founder members of the F.A. of Wales and to this day remain full members. Between 1886 and 1894, Chirk were winners of the Welsh Senior Cup on no fewer than 5 occasions

The early Chirk teams were mainly composed of miners from the two now closed village coal mines. The Chirk sides soon gained the “Colliers” nickname which has lasted to the present day and is a fitting and proud link.

The first half of the twentieth century saw Chirk compete in the Welsh League, Combination League, Liverpool Combination League and The Welsh National League where they played since 1945. The only exception being when they spent one season in the Cymru Alliance in 1997.

Chirk have won the Welsh Cup on no fewer than 5 occasions.

They first won it in 1887 when they beat Davenham 4-2. Chirk went on to win it another 4 times in the following 7 years, the last time when beating Westminster Rovers 2-0 in 1894 with Billy Meredith in the team. Chirk were also losing finalists in 1892 when we lost 2-1 to Wrexham.

Chirk can boast no fewer than 33 Welsh Internationals with a total of 246 full Welsh caps, 72 of these caps won while playing for Chirk! The most famous of these being Billy Meredith
